Jack continues to be top rookie in rounds 3 & 4

Rounds 3 & 4 of the 2010 Renault Clio Cup with Michelin saw Jack build on his great start to the season with a strong 8th place finish on Saturday and a hard charging 7th place in the second race on Sunday.



Qualifying started with Jack topping the timesheets, but by the end of the 30 minute session he was forced to settle for 9th. With the gap between 3rd and 9th being only 3/10 of a second a top 3 qualifying position will be well within Jack's grasp. Jack's brief again for these last rounds was to keep the impetuous going forward, keep out of trouble and bring home some valuable championship points, which he delivered with aplomb by being the top rookie finisher in both rounds.

Driver Coach Danny Buxton says "After a steady performance in the first race at Rockingham I was extremely impressed and happy to see Jack raise his game in race two. His first few laps were exactly what I had asked of him; aggressive, racy and determined. He looked as if he could win the race at one point! I think that has given him an insight into how he has to drive all the time, so with that in mind, bring on Brands Hatch!"

Jack commented that he was really happy with his overall weekend's performance and feels he has upped his game to now be pushing the front runners, "I am now looking to make the next step forward this coming weekend at Brands Hatch."
