Goff Secures Second Season With RCIB Insurance Racing

Jack Goff will continue with RCIB Insurance Racing for a second consecutive season in the Dunlop MSA British Touring Car Championship.

Driving the Vauxhall Insignia again, the 22-year-old showed great speed in his maiden campaign which culminated in a stunning drive in the final race of the season. Fighting with outgoing champion Gordon Shedden to the end, Goff took a second place, his first time on the BTCC rostrum.

At times in 2013, Goff had been struggling for budget but his performances at the latter half of the year along with hard work away from the circuit has allowed him to secure a second season in the BTCC.

"The last race of the season has certainly helped me over the winter," Goff told btcc.net. "I'm lucky in that my sponsors have stuck with me over the last few years - RCIB Insurance, HSL, and all the other guys make this possible, so it's great to be out there fighting for them again.

"It's brilliant to have a second year. We had no testing or development last year, so with every race meeting I was learning the car and the team was learning the set-up, but we had good speed even if we couldn't show it in all the races.

With a host of new partners and sponsors as well as new team members, Goff is relishing the prospect of fighting at the front however he knows it will not be easy.

Goff added: *"We've brought in some new personnel to the team as well which should really help with*
